Kazakhstan was represented by Aliya Yessylbayeva, Xeniya Yakimchik, Nuriya Abdolova, ABIKENOVA GULZIRA, and Suleimenova Assemgul, who also received a special award. In the painting category, Julia Cohen represented Israel, Mayya Zhulidova and Natallia Shelhunova represented Spain, Perle Vaisietaite represented Lithuania, and Zanna Dudzinska represented Estonia.
